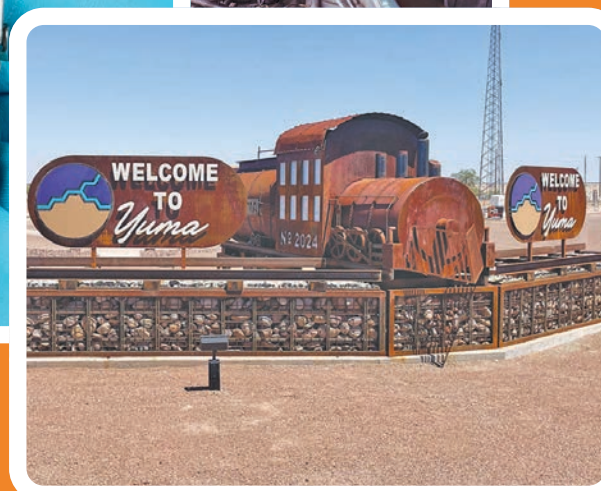
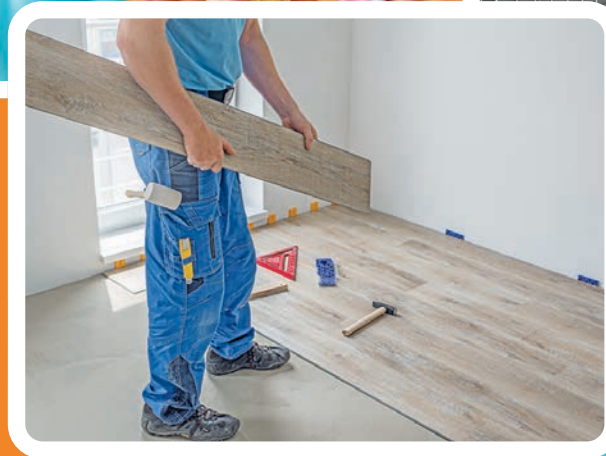

HOW TO

CHOOSE A COMMERCIAL OR RESIDENTIAL CLEANING COMPANY

Choose a Place to RV Camp Just Outside the Los Algodones, Mexico Border

For many travelers heading to Los Algodones, the best lodging choice isn't inside Mexico at all—it's just across the border on the U.S. side in areas like Winterhaven or Yuma. 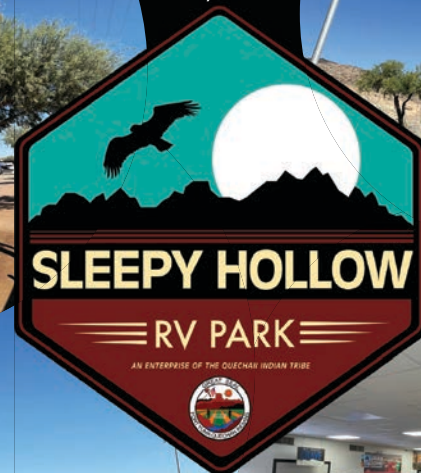
